# WHAT YOUR GIFT MAKES POSSIBLE

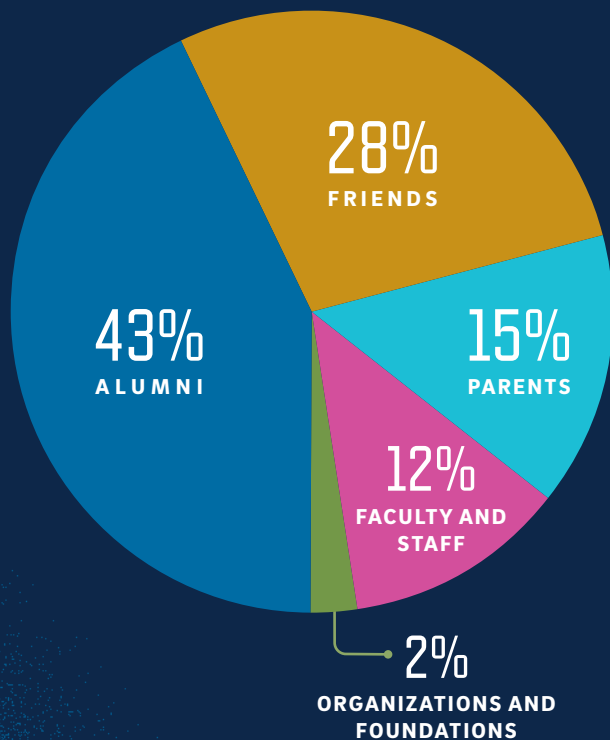
